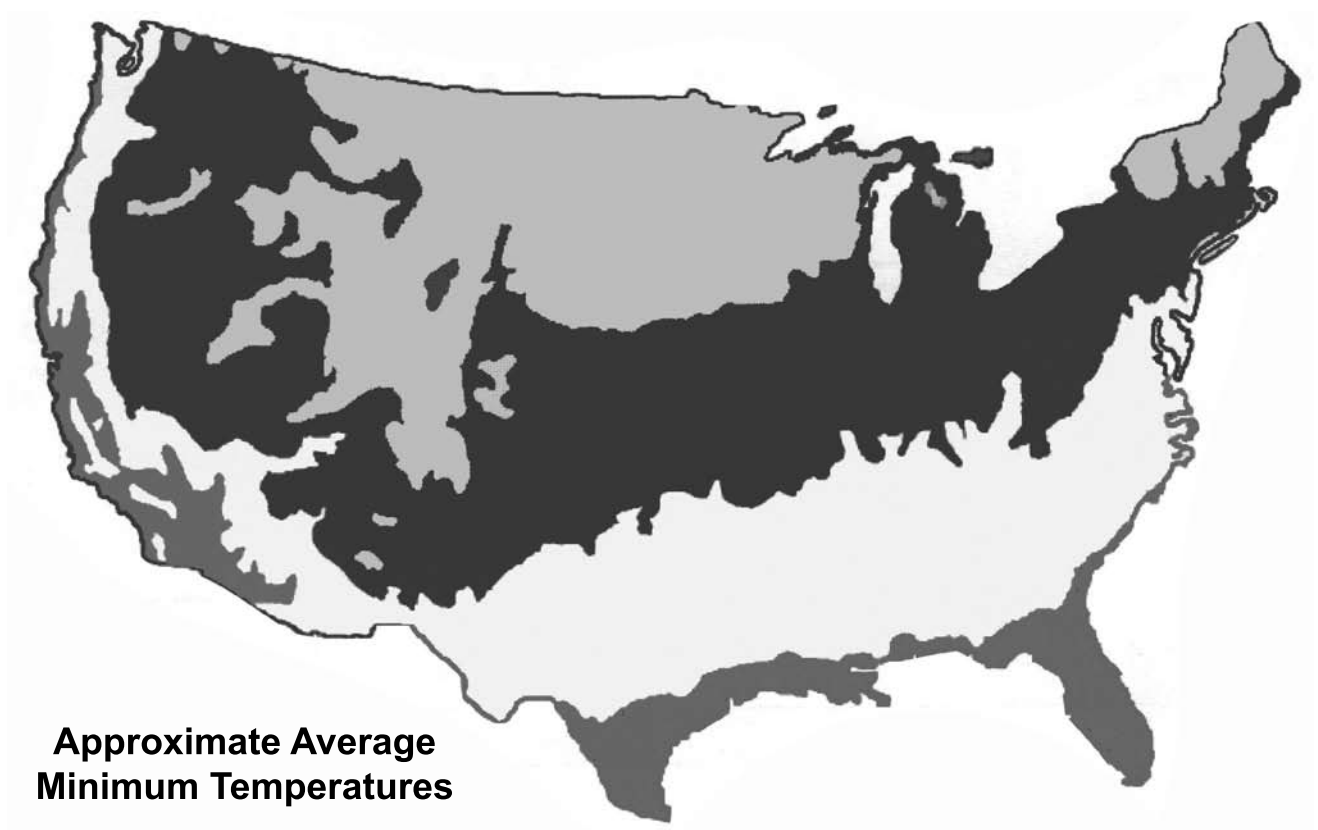
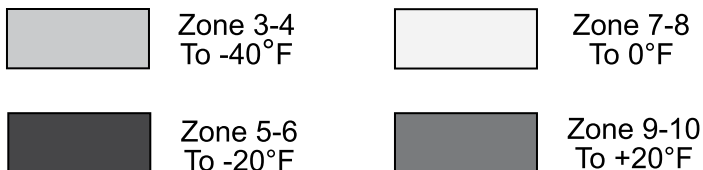


Wherever You Live...

It's Easy!

- Prepare the soil ...

Dig the planting bed to a depth of 12-18", using a garden fork and spade. For larger areas, you may want to use a rototiller.

- Plant your bulbs ...

Be sure to note the depth at which your bulbs should be planted - this is very important. Bulbs planted too deep or too shallow may not bloom. For best results, add a measure of bone meal to the hole at planting time.

- Water well ... then enjoy!

There's nothing else to do! Your bulbs will bloom reliably come summer!
